

LIST OF REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR FMP SUBMITTALS

"FMP" stands for **"Flood Mitigation Project"**, or an infrastructure-altering activity. TWDB assumes that a study has taken place prior to an FMP being submitted and that significant information is readily available.

To support an **FMP submittal**, the following information is **required**:

• An image of the desired model limits in PDF, JPG, or PNG format with landmarks or street names shown **AND** a brief (not to exceed one page) description of the project and why it is beneficial to the community

OR a report of the previous study that describes the submitted alternative in PDF format

- A GIS-based file of the desired model limits in .shp format
- Hydrologic models (if applicable) and hydraulic models showing both existing conditions and post-project conditions of the desired alternative

To support an **FMP submittal**, the following information is **encouraged but not required**:

- A cost estimate for the proposed project construction
- A benefit-cost analysis for the desired alternative
- A description or proof that the project does not cause adverse impacts outside of the community's right-of-way (can be included in the report).
