



LIST OF REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR FMS SUBMITTALS

“FMS” stands for “Flood Management Strategies”, or a flood-risk-reducing activity that does not easily fit the definition of an FME or an FMP. FMSs may not always affect the flooding in an area as much as the awareness of flooding in an area, so the information requirements are different than FMEs and FMPs.

To support an **FMS submittal**, the following information is **required**:

- A GIS-based file of the improvement limits in .shp format
- A brief (not to exceed one page) description of the activity and its benefit to the community
 - Any known implementation issues (can be included in the one-page description)
- A cost estimate of the proposed activity
- A benefit-cost analysis for the desired alternative
- A completed FMS Input Table Excel spreadsheet. (See template.)
